Read Mark 6:45-56

(1) The text says that after Jesus had dismissed the crowds, he went up on the mountain alone to pray. What principles can we glean from this verse?

(2) We are told that the disciples were struggling under the conditions of the wind and sea, and as a result, found themselves off course, weary and fearful. How have you been able to relate to these similar predicaments the disciples found themselves in?

(3) Jesus then responds to their trouble and tells them he is near to to them and not to fear. How has God's Word been a source of refuge in times of trouble in your own life?

(4) Read Matthew 14:28-33. What are some encouraging things we can glean from this account?
